## Animal welfare payments

For the implementation of the documented requirements during the term of the certificate, the sponsoring company shall pay an animal welfare payment to eligible livestock producers. The amount of the animal welfare payment shall be determined upon conclusion of the initial registration phase. Depending on the respective number of participants in each of the sectors "Domestic turkey production" and "Foreign turkey production" - an animal welfare payment shall be paid of at least 2.5 cents per kilogram live weight for turkey hens and 3.0 cents per kilogram live weight for turkey cocks. Should the number of participants permit, a higher animal welfare payment, this can amount to up to 3.25 cents per kilogram live weight for turkey hens and 4.0 cents per kilogram live weight for turkey cocks. The decision with regard to the amount of the animal welfare payment shall be made by the "Initiative Tierwohl" animal welfare initiative financial committee.

The animal welfare payment shall be made based on location via one of the clearing houses appointed by the sponsoring company. At the clearing house, separate accounts for domestic and foreign turkey producers will be held depending on the respective market share. Unless otherwise decided by the finance committee, animal welfare payments shall be made exclusively from the respective account. The ratio of domestic to foreign product is ascertained at regular intervals by the finance committee and fixed for the purpose of distribution within the animal welfare initiative for poultry (Initiative Tierwohl Geflügel).

Livestock owners, who are already obligated to implement a greater amount of available space due regulations contained in animal protection legislation shall not receive animal welfare payments (for example in Germany, pursuant to current legislation, The Order on the Protection of Animals and the Keeping of Production Animals [Tierschutz-Nutztierhaltungsverordnung], or the European Organic Regulations).
